REGION This weekend, the Firemen's Association of the State of New York urges residents to replace the batteries in the smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors in their houses.

Daylight **Saving** Time ends at 2 a.m. Sunday.

FASNY also recommends that **homeowners** dust or vacuum their smoke detectors to keep them free of debris, so they can work properly.
