

NYS Academy of Fire Science Librarian: CDL Practice Test

Recent legislative changes to the CDL requirements for the NY State fire service have raised awareness of this aspect of driver training. Those interested in taking a CDL practice test can use their NY Public Library card to do just that! Don't have a card? It's free to anyone in New York State.*

To apply online for the "Branch" card go to <https://catalog.nypl.org/selfreg~S1>. You'll get your card and PIN for online databases in 7-14 days. Once you get your NYPL card, go to <http://www.learnatest.com/LEL/index.cfm/general> and register using your library card number (not your PIN #) and any password you choose. The "Jobs & Careers" category will lead you to the CDL prep tests.
