WHAT'S HAPPENING

Every even year, before the start of a new legislative cycle, November's event will remain the traditional conference and serve as the forum for ratifying new priorities. In odd years, however, it will shift to a mid-session workshop to assess Year 1 wins and losses, with more space for deep policy discussions with decisionmakers and experts, ensuring that Year 2 continues to advance the Association's priorities.

This year's event will take place Saturday, November 1 at the Hilton Garden Inn in Troy, N.Y.

WHY IT WORKS

- Aligns association with the legislative cycle, in which session priorities are worked over a 2-year cycle
- Positions FASNY to lead, not follow
- Deep dive into policy issues to equip members with the tools to facilitate change in districts and in Albany
- Short, sharp, and designed for action
